**Questions and Scriptures for further study**

1. Read Ephesians 2:1-22. In vs. 1-10, what does Paul say our condition without Christ is? How does this contrast with what God does for us when we put our faith in Jesus?
  
2. We are told in vs. 10 that God has prepared good works for us to do. What are those for you? Is there anything that hinders you from doing them?
  
3. Paul uses vivid imagery in vs. 11-22. What does this image tell us about the division between Jews and Gentiles? What does it help us understand about the unity we find in Christ?
  
4. What is Paul helping us see about how the gospel impacts our relationships with others?
  
5. Are there rules or requirements you tend to try to enforce (like the law in vs. 15) that could hinder someone from coming to Jesus? Is there a step you can take to grow in unity with another Christian this week?

**Family Devo:** Read Ephesians 2:11-22. Paul is helping us see how Jesus helps us have a relationship with God and this also helps us have strong relationships with other people, even those very different from us. Talk together about how Jesus can help us love those who are different from us.
