
Acts 1:11 (NIV)

Mark 13:35 (NIV)


"Therefore keep watch because you do not know when the owner of the house will come back—whether in the evening, or at midnight, or when the rooster crows, or at dawn.





1 Thessalonians 5:2-3 (ESV)

2 For you yourselves are fully aware that the day of the Lord will come like a thief in the night. 3 While people are saying, "There is peace and security," then <u>sudden destruction will come upon them</u> <u>as labor pains come upon a pregnant</u> woman, and they will not escape.



Matthew 24:37 (NIV) As it was in the days of Noah, so it will be at the coming of the Son of Man.



1 Thessalonians 4:16 (NIV)

For the Lord himself will come down from heaven, with a loud command, with the voice of the archangel and with the trumpet call of God, and the dead in Christ will rise first.



Luke 21:27 (NIV) At that time they will see the Son of Man coming in a cloud with power and great glory.





1 Thessalonians 4:13-14 (ESV)

13 But we do not want you to be uninformed, brothers, about those who are asleep, that you may not grieve as others do who have no hope. 14 For since we believe that Jesus died and rose again, even so, through Jesus, **God will bring with him those who have fallen asleep.**



1 Thessalonians 4:15-17 (ESV)

15 For this we declare to you by a word from the Lord, that we who are alive, who are left until the coming of the Lord, will not precede those who have fallen asleep. 16 For the Lord himself will descend from heaven with a cry of command, with the voice of an archangel, and with the sound of the trumpet of God. And the dead in Christ will rise first. 17 Then we who are alive, who are left, will be caught up together with them in the clouds to meet the Lord in the air, and so we will always be with the Lord.



1 Corinthians 15:51-52 (NIV)

51 Listen, I tell you a mystery: We will not all sleep, but we will all be changed—52 in a flash, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trumpet. For the trumpet will sound, the dead will be raised imperishable, and we will be changed.






1 Thessalonians 5:4-5 (ESV)

1 Thessalonians 5:6-7 (ESV)


6 So then let us not sleep, as others do, but let us keep awake and be sober. 7 For those who sleep, sleep at night, and those who get drunk, are drunk at night.

8 But since we belong to the day, let us be sober, having put on the breastplate of faith and love, and for a helmet the hope of salvation.








John 14:1-3 (NIV)
