2nd Sam. 6: 11 - 12.....The Ark of the LORD remained there in Obed-edom's house for three months, and the LORD blessed Obededom and his entire household. 12 Then King David was told, "The LORD has blessed Obededom's household and everything he has because of the Ark of God."



1st Sam. 4:21-22.... She named the child Ichabod (which means "Where is the glory?"), for she said, "Israel's glory is gone." She named him this because the Ark of God had been captured and because her father-in-law and husband were dead. 22 Then she said, "The glory has departed from Israel, for the Ark of God has been captured."

BEING RICH IN GLORY OF GOD



John 1: 14....So the Word became human[d] and made his home among us. He was full of unfailing love and faithfulness.[e] And we have seen his glory, the glory of the Father's one and only Son.



John 2:11.... This miraculous sign at Cana in Galilee was the first time Jesus revealed his glory. And his disciples believed in him.



2nd Peter 2:16 – 17...16 For we were not making up clever stories when we told you about the powerful coming of our Lord Jesus Christ. We saw his majestic splendor with our own eyes 17 when he received honor and glory from God the Father. The voice from the majestic glory of God said to him, "This is my dearly loved Son, who brings me great joy."[f] 18 We ourselves heard that voice from heaven when we were with him on the holy mountain.

Ephesians 3: 20 – 21... Now to him who is able to do far more abundantly than all that we ask or think, according to the power at work within us, 21 to him be glory in the church and in Christ Jesus throughout all generations, forever and ever. Amen.

2nd Corinth. 3: 7 – 11....7 The old way, [b] with laws etched in stone, led to death, though it began with such glory that the people of Israel could not bear to look at Moses' face. For his face shone with the glory of God, even though the brightness was already fading away. 8 Shouldn't we expect far greater glory under the new way, now that the Holy Spirit is giving life? 9 If the old way, which brings condemnation, was glorious, how much more glorious is the new way, which makes us right with God! 10 In fact, that first glory was not glorious at all compared with the overwhelming glory of the new way. 11 So if the old way, which has been replaced, was glorious, how much more glorious is the new, which remains forever!
