[21] Therefore if anyone cleanses himself from the latter, he will be a vessel for honor, sanctified and useful for the Master, prepared for every good work. [22] Flee also youthful lusts; but pursue righteousness, faith, love, peace with those who call on the Lord out of a pure heart.



# 1 Timothy 2:20-26

[23] But avoid foolish and ignorant disputes, knowing that they generate strife. [24] And a servant of the Lord must not quarrel but be gentle to all, able to teach, patient, [25] in humility correcting those who are in opposition, if God perhaps will grant them repentance, so that they may know the truth, [26] and that they may come to their senses and escape the snare of the devil, having been taken captive by him to do his will.



#### PURE HEART

- Decerning Heart
- Gentle Manner
- Humble spirit (power under control)
- Confrontive will (Not for your own sake)

#### Practice of Honour

- Maintain a solid relationship with God, and wise one with men
- Beat your body to attain excellence of the heart (crisis don't destroy a gift, they manifest the gift)
- Serve men with your gifts/skills for God's glory(purpose).
