




# 2022 - OURYEAR OF SUPERNATURAL INCREASE









#### 2 Thessalonians 3:1-2


1 Finally, dear brothers and sisters, we ask you to **pray for us**. **Pray** that the Lord's message will spread rapidly and be honored wherever it goes, just as when it came to you. 2 **Pray**, too, that we will be rescued from wicked and evil people, for not everyone is a believer



# 2 Thessalonians 3:3-4

3 But the Lord is faithful; he will strengthen you and guard you from the evil one. 4 And we are confident in the Lord that you are doing and will continue to do the things we commanded you.









# 2 Thessalonians 3:6 (AMP)

6 And now, dear brothers and sisters, we give you this <u>command in</u>

the name of our Lord Jesus Christ: Stay away from all believers who live <u>idle</u> [irregularly: fluctuating morality] lives and don't follow the <u>tradition</u> they received from us.







#### 2 Thessalonians 3:7-10

For you know that you ought to imitate us. We were not idle when we were with you. 8 We never accepted food from anyone without paying for it. We worked hard day and night so we would not be a burden to any of you. 9 We certainly had the right to ask you to feed us, but we wanted to give you an example to follow. 10 Even while we were with you, we gave you this command: "Those unwilling to work will not get to eat."




#### 2 Thessalonians 3:11-13


11 Yet we hear that some of you are living <u>idle lives</u>, refusing to work and meddling in other people's business. 12 We command such people and urge them in the name of the Lord Jesus Christ to <u>settle down</u> and work to earn their own living. 13 As for the rest of you, dear brothers and sisters, never get tired of doing good.



# 2 Thessalonians 3:3-4 (ESV)

14 <u>Take note</u> of those who refuse to obey what we say in this letter. Stay away from them so they will be <u>ashamed</u>. 15 <u>Don't think of</u> <u>them as enemies</u>, but warn them as you would a brother or sister.









#### 1 Thessalonians 3:11

Now God <u>himself</u> and our Father, and our Lord Jesus Christ, direct our way unto you.

# 1 Thessalonians 5:23-24

Now may the God of peace <u>Himself</u> sanctify you completely; and may your whole spirit, soul, and body be preserved blameless at the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ. 24 He who calls you is faithful, who also will do it.




#### 2 Thessalonians 2:16-17


