And with great power the apostles were giving their testimony to the resurrection of the Lord Jesus, and great grace was upon them all.






Luke 2:52 (NIV)

1 Now Samuel died, and all Israel gathered for his funeral. They buried him at his house in Ramah. Then David moved down to the wilderness of Maon. 2 There was a wealthy man from Maon who owned property near the town of Carmel. He had 3,000 sheep and 1,000 goats, and it was sheep-shearing time.






3 This man's name was Nabal, and his wife, Abigail, was a <u>sensible and</u> <u>beautiful woman</u>. But Nabal, a descendant of Caleb, was <u>crude and mean</u> <u>in all his dealings</u>.




14 Meanwhile, one of Nabal's servants went to Abigail and told her, "David sent messengers from the wilderness to greet our master, but <u>he</u> <u>screamed insults at them</u>



4 When David heard that Nabal was shearing his sheep, 5 he sent ten of his young men to Carmel with this message for Nabal: 6 "Peace and prosperity to you, your family, and everything you own! 7 I am told that it is sheep-shearing time. While your shepherds stayed among us near Carmel, we never harmed them, and nothing was ever stolen from them.




8 Ask your own men, and they will tell you this is true. So would you be kind to us, since we have come at a time of celebration? Please share any provisions you might have on hand with us and with your friend David." 9 David's young men gave this message to Nabal in David's name, and they waited for a reply.




1 Samuel 25:29-30

29 "Even when you are chased by those who seek to kill you, your life is safe in the care of the Lord your God, secure in his treasure pouch! But the lives of your enemies will disappear like stones shot from a sling!

30 When the Lord has done all he promised and has made you leader of Israel



31 don't let this be a blemish on your record. Then your conscience won't have to bear the staggering burden of needless bloodshed and vengeance. And when the Lord has done these great things for you, please remember me, your servant!"






1 Samuel 25:10-11


1 Samuel 25:15-17

He's so ill-tempered that no one can even talk to him!"




1 Samuel 25:23-24







11 Should I take my bread and my water and my meat that I've slaughtered for my shearers and give it to a band of outlaws who come from who knows where?"





Bless you for keeping me from murder and from carrying out vengeance with my own hands. 34 For I swear by the Lord, the God of Israel, who has kept me from hurting you, that if you had not hurried out to meet me, not one of Nabal's men would still be alive tomorrow morning." 35 Then David accepted her present and told her, "Return home in peace. I have heard what you said. We will not kill your husband."
