
John 2:1-5,11


Some things you should know about Jesus before this wedding


- 4. He already had a third of His disciples with Him.
- 5. He had all the power in the world to perform miracles and do wonderous things, but still felt His hour had not yet come.







Some Key notes


- 1. Not everyone or every circumstance can motivate you or push you to act.

- 3. That person, mostly represents a motherly figure in our lives. These people have the ability to love us unconditionally.



















1 Samuel 1:10-11
