#### John 11:1-2 (ESV)

1 Now a certain man was ill, Lazarus of Bethany, the village of Mary and her sister Martha. 2 It was Mary who anointed the Lord with ointment and wiped his feet with her hair, whose **brother Lazarus was ill**.



#### John 11:3 (ESV)

3 So the sisters sent to him, saying, "Lord, he whom you love is ill."



John 11:1–2 (ESV)

5 Now Jesus loved Martha and her sister and Lazarus. 6 So, when he heard that Lazarus was ill, he stayed two days longer in the place where he was.



#### John 11:5-6 (ESV)

1 Now a certain man was ill, Lazarus of Bethany, the village of Mary and her sister Martha. 2 It was Mary who anointed the Lord with ointment and wiped his feet with her hair, whose **brother Lazarus was ill**.



#### John 11:36 (ESV)

36 So the Jews said, "See how he loved him!"



#### Romans 8:38-39

38 For I am sure that neither death nor life, nor angels nor rulers, nor things present nor things to come, nor powers, 39 nor height nor depth, nor anything else in all creation, will be able to **separate us from the love of God in Christ Jesus** our Lord.



#### Ephesians 3:18-19

18 may have power, together with all the Lord's holy people, to grasp how wide and long and high and deep is the love of Christ, 19 and to know this love that surpasses knowledge—that you may be filled to the measure of all the fullness of God.

#### John 11:4 (ESV)

4 But when Jesus heard it he said, "This illness does not lead to death. It is for the glory of God, so that the Son of God may be glorified through it."



#### John 11:37 (ESV)

37 But some of them said, "Could not he who opened the eyes of the blind man also have kept this man from dying?"



#### Romans 8:28

28 And we know that for those who love God <u>all things work together for</u> <u>good</u>, for those who are called according to his purpose



#### John 11:39-40 (ESV)

39 Jesus said, "Take away the stone." Martha, the sister of the dead man, said to him, "Lord, by this time there will be an odor, for he has been dead four days." 40 Jesus said to her, "Did I not tell you that **if you believed** you would see the glory of God?"



#### John 11:33 (ESV)

33 When Jesus saw her weeping, and the Jews who had come with her also weeping, he was deeply moved in his spirit and greatly troubled.



35 Jesus wept.





#### John 11:38 (ESV)

38 Then Jesus, deeply moved again, came to the tomb. It was a cave, and a stone lay against it.



#### Hebrews 4:15

15 For we do not have a high priest who is unable to sympathize with our weaknesses, but one who in every respect has been tempted as we are, yet without sin.

#### John 11:20-22 (ESV)

20 So when Martha heard that Jesus was coming, she went and met him, but Mary remained seated in the house. 21 Martha said to Jesus, "Lord, if you had been here, my brother would not have died. 22 <u>But even now I</u> know that whatever you ask from God, God will give you."



#### Matthew 7:7-8

7 "Ask, and it will be given to you; seek, and you will find; knock, and it will be opened to you. 8 For everyone who asks receives, and the one who seeks finds, and to the one who knocks it will be opened.



#### John 11:32 (ESV)

32 Now when Mary came to where Jesus was and saw him, she fell at his feet, saying to him, "Lord, if you had been here, my brother would not have died."



#### Matthew 19:26

26 But Jesus looked at them and said, "With man this is impossible, but with God all things are possible."



#### John 11:25 (ESV)

25 Jesus said to her, "I am the resurrection and the life. Whoever believes in me, though he die, yet shall he live, 26 and everyone who lives and believes in me shall never die. **Do you believe this?**"



#### John 11:41 (ESV)

41 So they took away the stone. And Jesus lifted up his eyes and said, "Father, I thank you that you have heard me.



#### John 11:43 (ESV)

43 When he had said these things, he cried out with a loud voice, "Lazarus, come out."



### CONCLUSION



#### John 11:44 (ESV)

44 The man who had died came out, his hands and feet bound with linen strips, and his face wrapped with a cloth. Jesus said to them, "<u>Unbind</u> <u>him, and let him go.</u>"
