ONE WITH A HISTORY AND AN ACCOUNT



Genesis 6:9

One with a HISTORY and an ACCOUNT

- Righteous (in right standing with God)
 (All scripture is Gods breath 2 Tim 3:16)
- Blameless (Less of blame) at your time, (INTEGRITY) being Steadfast (James 1:4 let steadfastness have its full effect so that you may be perfect and complete lacking nothing.

OHENE BERNARD

Acts 13:22 (NIV)

22 After removing Saul, he made David their king. God testified concerning him: 'I have found David son of Jesse, a man after my own heart; he will do everything I want him to do.'



- > David was a man who committed adultery
- > who had one of his closest friends murdered
- he had so much blood on his hands that God said David could not be the man to rebuild His temple in Jerusalem.



1 Chronicles 28:3 (NKJV)

But God said to me, 'You shall not build a house for My name, because you have been a man of war and have shed blood.'



SO WHY IS DAVID A MAN AFTER GOD'S OWN HEART?



- > David did not deny his mistakes
- > he didn't try to lie to God or make up excuses
- > he understood he was a sinner before God.
- That he needed God to forgive Him.
- > That God is loving, so He would forgive Him.

FIRST KEY: AWAKENING



Luke 15:14-17

14 After he had spent everything, there was a severe famine in that whole country, and he began to be in need. 15 So he went and hired himself out to a citizen of that country, who sent him to his fields to feed pigs. 16 He longed to fill his stomach with the pods that the pigs were eating, but no one gave him anything. 17 "When he came to his senses, he said, 'How many of my father's hired servants have food to spare, and here I am starving to death!



SECOND KEY: HONESTY



Luke 15:18

18 I will set out and go back to my father and say to him: **Father, I have sinned** against heaven and against you. 19 I am no longer worthy to be called your son; make me like one of your hired servants.'

THRDKEY: ACTION



Luke 15:20

20a So he got up and went to his father.

20b "But while he was still a long way off, his father saw him and was filled with compassion for him; he ran to his son, threw his arms around him and kissed him.

QUALIFICATIONS of a MAN after God's own Heart

- A man after God's heart has to be called by God and he needs to accept God's call; (Exodus 3:2-10)
- A man after the heart of God is not perfect, he is made perfect by God. This means that only God has the requirements. (Exodus 3:11, 13; 4:1, 10)
- > When you are a man after the heart of God you become a father. (Genesis 45:8)

AFTER GOD'S OWN HEART

QUALITIES of a MAN after God's own Heart

1. He was a symbol of authority: Moses was a leader, ruler, controller and a manager. He was able to make timely and Godly decisions: (Exodus 2:11, Exodus 4 and 5)



QUALITIES of a MAN after God's own Heart

2. He was vision oriented: he was dedicated to his call and mission and hence, needed more of God.



QUALITIES of a MAN after God's own Heart

3. He exhibited and displayed love, a different kind of love that is selfless, sacrificial and affectionate. (Exodus 32:32, Deuteronomy 9:18)
