- **Spontaneity**: Recognize God's voice as spontaneous thoughts which light upon your mind.
- **Stillness**: Quiet yourself so you can hear God's voice.
- **Vision**: Look for vision as you pray.
- **Journaling**: Write down the flow of thoughts and pictures that come to you.

Ephesians 1:18 (NLT)

18 I pray that your hearts will be flooded with light so that you can understand the confident hope he has given to those he called—his holy people who are his rich and glorious inheritance.

ACTIVATION 1
