Philippians 3:3 (NIV)

3 For it is we who are the circumcision, we who serve God by his Spirit, who boast in Christ Jesus, and who put no confidence in the flesh—

Romans 2:28-29 (NIV)

28 A person is not a Jew who is one only outwardly, nor is circumcision merely outward and physical. 29 No, <u>a person is a Jew who is one inwardly; and circumcision is circumcision of the heart, by the Spirit</u>, not by the written code. Such a person's praise is not from other people, but from God.

Colossians 2:11-12 (NIV)

11 In him you were also circumcised with a circumcision not performed by human hands. Your whole self ruled by the flesh was put off when you were circumcised by Christ, 12 having been buried with him in baptism, in which you were also raised with him through your faith in the working of God, who raised him from the dead.

Philippians 3:4-6 (NIV)

4 though I myself have reasons for such confidence.

If someone else thinks they have reasons to put confidence in the flesh,

I have more: 5 circumcised on the eighth day, of the people of Israel, of the tribe of Benjamin, a Hebrew of Hebrews; in regard to the law, a Pharisee; 6 as for zeal, persecuting the church; as for righteousness based on the law, faultless.

Philippians 3:10a (NIV)

10 I want to know Christ—yes, to know the power of his resurrection...

Ephesians 1:19-20 (NIV)

19 and his incomparably great power for us who believe. That power is the same as the mighty strength 20 he exerted when he raised Christ from the dead and seated him at his right hand in the heavenly realms,

Philippians 3:10b (NIV)

10...and participation in his sufferings, becoming like him in his death,

2 Corinthians 1:5 (NIV)

5 For just as we share abundantly in the sufferings of Christ, so also our comfort abounds through Christ.

Philippians 3:11 (NIV)

11 and so, somehow, attaining to the resurrection from the dead.

Ephesians 4:13 (NIV)
