Ephesians 2:6-7 (ESV)

6 and raised us up with him and <u>seated us with him in the</u>

<u>heavenly places in Christ Jesus</u>, 7 so that in the coming ages he

toward us in Christ Jesus.

Ephesians 2:8-9 (ESV)

8 For by grace you have been saved through faith. And this is not your own doing; it is the gift of God, 9 not a result of works, so that no one may boast.

Ephesians 2:10 (ESV)

10 For we are his workmanship, <u>created in Christ Jesus for good</u> works, which God prepared beforehand, that we should walk in them.
