There are a lot of things you need to do this new year. There are a lot of things you can and will do. But what's one thing you must do? Maybe just as importantly—what might keep you from doing it?




SECOND READING

Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has blessed us in Christ with every spiritual blessing in the heavenly places, just as he chose us in Christ before the foundation of the world to be holy and blameless before him in love. He destined us for adoption as his children through Jesus Christ, according to the good pleasure of his will, to the praise of his glorious grace that he freely bestowed on us in the Beloved. 


P: The Holy Gospel according to John, the 1st chapter.



GOSPEL

He was in the world, and the world came into being through him; yet the world did not know him. He came to what was his own, and his own people did not accept him.
