1. PURSUE
Therefore <u>if you have any</u> encouragement from being united with Christ, <u>if any</u> comfort from his love, <u>if any</u> common sharing in the Spirit, <u>if any</u> tenderness and compassion, (Php 2:1).
then <u>make my joy complete</u> by being like-minded, having the same love, <u>being one</u> <u>in spirit and of one mind.</u> (Php 2:2).
Unity doesn't happen by accident. It grows where humility replaces rivalry and self- interest gives way to service.
Do nothing out of selfish ambition or vain conceit. Rather, in humility value others above yourselves , 4 not looking to your own interests but each of you to the interests of the others . (Php 2:3–4).
I plead with Euodia and I plead with Syntyche to be of the same mind in the Lord. (Php 4:2).
