## **HOW TO FIND PEACE IN EVERY SITUATION?**

1. MAKE PEA	CE A
I plead with Euodia (prosperity) and I plead with Syntyche (fortunate) to be of the same mind in the Lord. (Php. 4:2)  Yes, and I ask you, my true companion, help these women since they have contended at my side in the cause of the gospel, along with Clement and the rest of my co-workers, whose names are in the book of life. (Php. 4:3)

	Jesus said, "If your brother sins against you, go and show him his fault, just between the two of you. If he listens to you, you have won your brother over. (Matthew 18:15)

2. PRAY YOUR WORRY INTO	
Four commands flow like drumbeats — short, sharp, unforgettable — the cadence of a peaceful soul.	
• Rejoice in the Lord always. I will say it again: Rejoice!	
<ul> <li>Let your <u>gentleness</u> be evident to all.</li> <li>Gentleness isn't just a private virtue; it's</li> </ul>	
• The Lord is <u>near.</u>	
<ul> <li> — His return is soon.</li> </ul>	
His presence is close.	
• Do not be anxious about anything, but in every situation, by <b>prayer and petition</b> ,	
with thanksgiving, present your requests to God.	
<ul> <li>Don't worry about <u>anything</u>; pray about <u>everything</u>.</li> </ul>

"The peace of God will guard your hearts and minds in Christ Jesus." (v.7)	
3. CURATE YOURLIFE: DWELL ON THE EXCELLENT	
Finally, brothers and sisters, whatever is <u>true</u> , whatever is <u>noble</u> , whatever is <u>right</u> , whatever is <u>pure</u> , whatever is <u>lovely</u> , whatever is <u>admirable</u> —if anything is <u>excellent</u> or <u>praiseworthy</u> — <u>think about such things.</u> (Php 4:8).
