WHAT ARE YOU "CALLED OUT" TO DO?
1. CALLED TO FOLLOW
As a <u>prisoner for the Lord</u> , then, I urge you to live a life <u>worthy of the calling</u> you have received. (Eph 4:1).
IT'S VERY ORTHOPRAXY
Be completely <u>humble and gentle</u> ; be <u>patient</u> , <u>bearing</u> with one another in love. (Eph 4:2).
Make <b>every effort</b> to keep <b>the unity of the Spirit</b> through the bond of peace. (Eph 4:3).
• IT'S WHAT YOU ORTHODOXY
There is one body and one Spirit— just as you were called to one hope when you were called— 5 one Lord, one faith, one baptism; 6 one God and Father of all, who is over all and through all and in all. (Eph 4:4–6).
"My prayer is not for them alone. I pray also for those who will believe in me through their message, that all of them may be one, Father, just as you are in me and I am in you. (John 17:21)
2. CALLED TO (VOCATION)
The English word "vocation" is strictly an equivalent of "call" or "calling."
But to each one of us grace has been given as Christ apportioned it. (Fph 4:7)

but to <u>each one of as grace has been given</u> as <u>offilist apportioned it</u>. (Epit 4.1)

However, he has given each one of us <u>a special gift</u> through the <u>generosity of Christ</u>. (Eph. 4:7) NLT

## Ascended, Descended, Ascended - What Jesus did for US!

SOME ARE CALLED TO
It was <u>he</u> who <u>gave some</u> to be apostles, some to be prophets, some to be evangelists, and some to be <u>pastors and teachers</u> , (Eph. 4:7)
Their responsibility is <b>to equip God's people</b> to do <b>his work</b> and <b>build up the church</b> , the body of Christ. (Eph. 4:12) NLT
Be shepherds of God's flock that is under your care, serving as overseers—not because you must, but because you are willing, as God wants you to be; not greedy for money, but <u>eager to serve</u> ; 3 not lording it over those entrusted to you, but being <u>examples to the flock</u> . 4 And when the <u>Chief Shepherd appears</u> , you will receive the crown of glory that will never fade away. (1 Pe 5:2–4).
3. CALLED TO
until <u>we all reach unity in the faith</u> and in the knowledge of the Son of God and <u>become mature</u> , attaining to the whole measure of <u>the fullness of Christ.</u> (Eph 4:13).
MATURITY INVOLVES
Then we will <u>no longer be infants</u> , <u>tossed</u> back and forth by the waves, and <u>blown</u> <u>here and there by every wind</u> of teaching and by the cunning and craftiness of men in their deceitful scheming. (Eph 4:14).
MATURITY INVOLVES STABILITY
Instead, <b>speaking the truth in love</b> , we will in all things <b>grow up into him</b> who is the Head, that is, Christ. (Eph 4:15).
MATURITY INVOLVES
From him the whole body, joined and held together by every supporting ligament, grows and builds itself up in love, as each part does its work. (Eph 4:16).
