The word "overshadow" carries the sense of **God's holy and powerful presence**, similar to the cloud that covered the tabernacle and appeared during the Transfiguration. Importantly, it is not a euphemism for conception and does not indicate any sexual intercourse between God and Mary. In Scripture, **the Holy Spirit coming "upon" a person always signifies a supernatural, divine work.**
