1. A RELIGIOUS LEADER _____ JESUS

Now there was a <u>man of the Pharisees</u> named Nicodemus, a member of the **Jewish** ruling council. (Jn 3:1).

- An important Jewish sect at the time of Jesus that was devoted to exact observance of the Jewish religion.
- A group that served as the judicial authority for the Jews. It was composed of "leading priests and other members of the non-priestly nobility". The group informally advised the high priest.

<u>He came to Jesus at night</u> and said, "Rabbi, we <u>know</u> you are a teacher who has come from God. For no one could perform the miraculous signs you are doing if God were not with him." (Jn 3:2).

How can a man be born when he is old?" Nicodemus asked. "Surely <u>he cannot enter</u> <u>a second time into his mother's womb</u> to be born!" (Jn 3:4).

3. YOUR ONLY CREDENTIAL IS BEING _

Jesus answered, "I tell you the truth, no one can enter the kingdom of God unless he is **born of water and the Spirit.** 6 Flesh gives birth to flesh, but **the Spirit gives birth to spirit**. 7 You should not be surprised at my saying, 'You must be born again.'

8 The wind blows wherever it pleases. You hear its sound, but you cannot tell where it comes from or where it is going. <u>So it is with everyone born of the Spirit</u>." (Jn 3:5–8).

"How can this be?" Nicodemus asked. (Jn 3:9).

I will sprinkle clean water on you, and you will be clean; I will cleanse you from all your impurities and from all your idols. 26 I will give you <u>a new heart</u> and <u>put a new spirit</u> <u>in you</u>; I will remove from you your heart of stone and give you a heart of flesh. 27 And I will <u>put my Spirit in you</u> and <u>move you to follow my decrees</u> and be careful to keep my laws. (Ezek. 36:25-27)

"You are Israel's teacher," said Jesus, "and <u>do you not understand these things?</u> I tell you the truth, we speak of what we know, and we testify to what we have seen, but still you people do not accept our testimony. <u>I have spoken to you of earthly things</u> <u>and you do not believe; how then will you believe if I speak of heavenly things</u>? (Jn 3:10–12).

4. JESUS OFFERS WORDS OF _____

Just as Moses lifted up the snake in the desert, **so the Son of Man must be lifted up**, 15 that **everyone who believes in him may have eternal life**.(Jn 3:14–15).

"For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that **whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life**. (John 3:16)

For God did not send his Son into the world to condemn the world, but <u>to save the</u> <u>world through him.</u> (John 3:17)

<u>Whoever believes in him is not condemned</u>, but whoever does not believe stands condemned already because he has not believed in the name of God's one and only Son. (Jn 3:18).
