 - **PSALMS OF <u>DISORIENTATION</u>** Human life consists in anguished seasons of hurt, alienation, suffering, and death.
 - PSALMS OF <u>NEW ORIENTATION</u> Human life consists in turns of surprise when we are overwhelmed with the new gifts of God, when joy breaks through the despair.
