| No, this is what was spoken by the prophet Joel: |
| In the last days, God says, I will pour out my Spirit on all people. Your sons and daughters will prophesy, your young men will see visions, your old men will dream dreams. Even on my servants, both men and women, I will pour out my Spirit in those days, and they will prophesy. (Ac 2:17–18). And everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved.' (Ac 2:21). |
| 3. THE FOCUS IS ON |
| "Men of Israel, listen to this: <u>Jesus of Nazareth was a man accredited by God</u> to you by miracles, wonders and signs, which God did among you through him, as you yourselves know. 23 <u>This man was handed over to you</u> by God's set purpose and foreknowledge; and <u>you, with the help of wicked men, put him to death by nailing him to the cross.</u> 24 But <u>God raised him from the dead</u> , freeing him from the agony of death, because <u>it was impossible for death to keep its hold on him</u> . (Ac 2:22–24). "Therefore let all Israel be assured of this: <u>God has made this Jesus, whom you crucified, both Lord and Christ.</u> " (Ac 2:36). |

| When the people heard this, they were <u>cut to the heart</u> and said to Peter and the other apostles, <u>"Brothers, what shall we do?"</u> (Ac 2:37). |
| Peter replied, "Repent and be baptized, every one of you, in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of your sins. And you will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit. 39 The promise is for you and your children and for all who are far off—for all whom the Lord our God will call." (Ac 2:38–39). |
