HOW TO LIVE CHRIST in a DIVIDED CULTURE?

1. LIVE AS CITIZENS OF
"Whatever happens, conduct yourselves in a manner worthy of the gospel of Christ." (Phil. 1:27)
The NIV's "conduct yourselves" fails to capture the full force of this imperative. What Paul literally commands is, "live as citizens" (politeusthe) or live out your citizenship.
- "But our citizenship is in heaven. And we eagerly await a Savior from there, the Lord Jesus Christ." (Phil. 3:20)
"Consequently, you are no longer foreigners and strangers, but fellow citizens with God's people and also members of his household." (Ephesians 2:19)
