1. IDENTIFY YOUR

This is how the birth of Jesus Christ came about: His mother Mary was <u>pledged</u> <u>to be married</u> to Joseph, but <u>before they came together</u>, she was found to be with child through the Holy Spirit. Because Joseph her husband was <u>a righteous</u> <u>man</u> and did not want <u>to expose her to public disgrace</u>, he had <u>in mind to</u> <u>divorce her quietly</u>. (Matt. 1:18-19 NIV)

2. _____ GOD'S ANSWER DILIGENTLY

But after he had considered this, an angel of the Lord appeared to him in a dream and said, "Joseph son of David, do not be afraid to take Mary home as your wife, because what is conceived in her is from the Holy Spirit. Matt. 1:20

3. CHECK YOUR ______ AND FOCUS ON THE CONSEQUENCES

"And you, my son Solomon, acknowledge the God of your father, and serve him with wholehearted devotion and with a willing mind, for **the LORD searches every heart and understands every motive behind the thoughts.** If you seek him, he will be found by you; but if you forsake him, he will reject you forever. 1Chr. 28:9

4. _____ FOR GOD'S REVELATION

an <u>angel of the Lord appeared to him in a dream</u> and said, "Joseph son of David, do not be afraid to take Mary home as your wife, because <u>what is</u> <u>conceived in her is from the Holy Spirit.</u> Matt. 1:20

She will give birth to a son, and **you are to give him the name Jesus**, because he will save his people from their sins." Matt. 1:21

All this took place to fulfill what the Lord had said through the prophet: "**The** virgin will be with child and will give birth to a son, and they will call him Immanuel" — which means, "God with us." Matt. 1:22-23

5. _____ IN OBEDIENCE

When Joseph woke up, **he did what the angel of the Lord had commanded him** and took Mary home as his wife. Matt. 1:24

But <u>he had no union with her</u> until she gave birth to a son. And he gave him the name Jesus. Matt. 1:25
