1. GOD IS A _____ GOD

*In the past **God spoke** to our ancestors through **the prophets at many times and in various ways**, 2 but in these last days **he has spoken to us by his Son**. . . (Heb 1:1–2).*

2. WHO IS THIS _____ ?

*whom **he appointed heir of all things**, and through whom also **he made the universe**. 3 The Son is the **radiance of God's glory** and the **exact representation of his being, sustaining all things** by his powerful word. After he had provided **purification for sins**, he **sat down at the right hand of the Majesty in heaven**. (Heb 1:2–3).*
