

Read Galatians 2:1-10

1. As you read this text and think through the sermon, what stands out to you, encourages you, or challenges you?
2. The Text says Paul spent 14 years doing ministry on his own before he visited Jerusalem. 14 years of Ministry, both for Paul and the Apostles in Jerusalem, and despite the years, we find that the gospel preached by both groups is in complete agreement. Does that encourage you? What does their unity tell us about the power and sovereignty of God?
3. In our text, we also see that Paul took Titus, a gentile, with him to Jerusalem. Why is that an important detail? What was Paul communicating about the Gospel of Jesus Christ by bringing an uncircumcised gentile with him to the Holy City of Israel?
4. In verses 4-5, what does it mean that he “did not yield in submission, even for a moment, so that the truth of the Gospel might be preserved”? What is the Truth of the Gospel?
5. How is God at work in the relationships of the apostles when you read vs 6-10? What does the response of Peter James and John to Paul's ministry and work tell us about how we should respond to each other in light of the Truth of the Gospel?
