(2) v13v & v15: Gospel freedom lovingly serves others.

(2) v14: Gospel freedom enables us to fulfill the law.

Read 5:13-15

1. What from this week’s passage or sermon encouraged or challenged you?
2. What are some ways we use our gospel freedom “as an opportunity for the flesh”?
3. If the Galatians main issue was legalism, why do you think Paul addressed licentiousness (using God’s grace as a license to disregard the law)? Do you tend to find yourself more influenced by the error of legalism or licentiousness?
4. Christian freedom is freedom **from** sin, not freedom **to** sin. How would you explain this to an unbeliever or a new Christian?
5. **Read John 13:35 and 1 John 4:20-21.** Why is our loving one another such an important and powerful indication of our love for God?
6. Share with your group about a time you found it hard to love another believer. How would better understanding your gospel freedom help you better love and serve this person?
