Throughout Scripture we see the importance of the (Ps. 139:13; John 1:1).
Christ's resurrection reveals the body is central to God's plan of (John 4:28-29; Acts 24:15)
Paul's response to the false teaching in Corinth that there is no bodily resurrection for believers:
(1) v1-11: Paul reminds them of the:
 a) v3: Christ died for our sins: i. Rom. 3:23 → All of humanity has and falls short of the glory of God ii. Rom 6:23a → The wages, or penalty and punishment for sin is iii. Rom 6:23b → The free gift of God is eternal in Christ Jesus our Lord (John 10:18)
 b) v4a: Christ was buried: i. His death was not a act, nor did He just to die ii. He died and was buried because God the Father's was poured out on Him for our sin
 c) v4b: Christ was raised on the 3rd day i. Our Lord did not just a perfect life to give you His righteousness ii. Our Lord did not just to take away your sin and the penalty for sin and save you from heliii. Our Lord was also raised to new & eternal life! (John 10:18b; Acts 2:24)
d) <i>v5-11: Christ appeared in His glorified, resurrected body</i> i. He appeared to women at the tomb, Peter, the Apostles, James, Paul and more than 500 people
(2) v12-20: Paul reveals the if there is no bodily resurrection for believers:
a) v13, 16: Christ has not been raised → If Christ was truly and died a real human death, then what is true of Him is true of us. If we are not raised, then Christ was not raised.
b) $v14a$: Preaching Christ is in vain \rightarrow Preaching about a man who cannot save is useless
c) $v14b$, 17a: Faith is in vain \rightarrow Our faith would be in a good moral who died and was buried
d) v15: We are misrepresenting $God \rightarrow An$ offense under the OT law that deserved
e) v17b: We are still in our sins → No = No = No
f) v18: The dead have perished \rightarrow No hope of them being in God's or seeing them again
g) v19: We are to be pitied \rightarrow Christian hope would be a hope restricted to this life only (v32)
