- (5) In v13-14, why do you think the Midianites were so fearful?
- (6) **Read Judges 7:19-22.** How does Gideon's army fight the battle in v21-22? According to v22, who is the real warrior of Israel and what does He do?
- (7) How are you being challenged to step out in faith and trust God's strength and promises?
- (8) How have we seen Gideon's faith evolve in Judges 6-7? How has your faith evolved?
