Read Galatians 2:11-14

1. As you read the passage and think through the sermon, what stands out to you, encourages you, or challenges you?
2. Why do you think the Bible describes the fear of man as a snare or a trap (Prov. 29:25)?
3. How have you experienced the fear of man recently? What about the opinions or approval of other people creates fear in you? How can this lead to hypocrisy?
4. In what ways can we insist other Christians should act like we do, or even hold them to a higher standard than we hold ourselves?
5. **Read Matt. 18:15-17.** Was Paul right to confront Peter publicly, and not to follow the pattern given in these verses? Why or why not (See 1 Tim. 5:20)?
6. What precedent does Paul’s confrontation with Peter set in regard to Christian accountability? Who are you allowing into your life to hold you accountable if you go astray?
