

Read Galatians 5:26-6:5

1. As you read this text and think through the sermon, what stands out to you, encourages you, or challenges you?
2. In Galatians 5:26, what attitudes does Paul warn believers against? Do you tend more toward provoking others (comparison/superiority) or envying others (inferiority/comparison)?
3. According to Galatians 6:1–2, what responsibilities do believers have toward one another? What does it mean to “bear one another’s burdens”?
4. In the sermon, we heard that “walking by the Spirit” is not vague spirituality but is revealed in how we treat others. Why is that important?
5. What keeps Christians from being honest about struggles, temptations, or weaknesses? Are there burdens you are trying to carry alone right now?
6. What would a church culture of genuine burden-bearing actually look like?
