- (1) **Read Romans 12:9-13.** When reading these verses, what comes to mind? Do you find these verses challenging or convicting? If so, in what way?
- (2) How should being part of the body of Christ, as described in these verses, shape your understanding of community and the need for "genuine" love? (Spend time reflecting on the example we have in the perfect love of Christ)
- (3) In what ways should the Gospel culture of the Church look different from the culture of the world?
- (4) Practically, how can we 'outdo one another in showing honor' and live a hospitable life? (See also Romans 15:1-7)
- (5) **Read Romans 12:12.** How does our being patient in tribulation and rejoicing in hope reflect the Gospel of Jesus? How is this an encouragement to others in gospel community?
- (6) How can we grow as a church in Gospel Culture? How can we grow (individually and as a community) in loving genuinely, showing honor, clinging to goodness, being hospitable, all while rejoicing in hope, being patient in tribulation, and constant in prayer?
