

Read Galatians 1:11-24

1. As you read this text and think through the sermon, what stands out to you, encourages you, or challenges you?
2. Why does Paul repeat the same thing he made clear in verses 1-10? That this Gospel is not man's Gospel but God's? Why is he making this such a priority?
3. What had the Pharisees prioritized? What had they(the Judaizers) been teaching the Galatians? How does Paul demonstrate that their gospel was not the true Gospel of Jesus?
4. Paul uses his testimony as the main defense of his calling and proof for the power of God in the Gospel of Jesus. How is your testimony proof of God's power at work?
5. The Pharisees prided themselves on being set apart by the law. What is Paul saying in these verses that sets us apart (verse 15)... or rather, why are we different than any other religion?

**PRAY** that God's church would constantly keep the scriptures, their testimony, and the Gospel of Jesus ever before them. Pray that we would be set apart purely by the grace of God and nothing else.
