- 3. **Read v2a and v8-9.** In what ways did the priests of Malachi's day fail to honor God and their responsibilities? How should the people of Israel have responded?
- 4. Read v1-3 and James 3:1. Why are leaders judged more strictly?
- 5. In what areas of your own life are you not willing to "listen...take it to heart to give honor" to God's name?
- 6. **Read 2 Cor. 5:18-20 and 1 Pet. 2:9.** How does the Lord's accusation against the priests of Malachi's day challenge your own responsibility as God's ambassador and priest?
- 7. How does the knowledge that Jesus is our Great High Priest provide you with both assurance where you have failed, as well as the motivation to be His ambassador and priest?
