

3 ways Paul refutes the false teaching that there is no resurrection of the body:

(1) v1-11: He reminds them of the gospel

(2) v12-19: He shows the implications if there is no resurrection from the dead

(3) v20-26: He reveals the results of Christ being raised from the dead
