

# EXODUS | 02 OT



Exodus is the second book of the Pentateuch (the five first books of the Bible), all written by Moses. However, it is the one most commonly sought to find information about both Moses and the Exodus, covering most well-known Bible stories, save his death (which is in Deuteronomy). The story of the Ten Plagues, while separated out for easier reference, can be viewed and studied as one story.

# Interesting Facts About Exodus

**MEANING:** Exodus is a Greek title meaning "exit," "departure," or "going out."

**AUTHOR:** Moses

**TIME WRITTEN:** 1445-1404 B. C.

**OBSERVATIONS ABOUT EXODUS:**

- 300 years separate Exodus from Genesis.
- Exodus is the record of Israel's birth as a nation.
- Exodus begins in pain and ends in liberation.
- 70 people entered Egypt (1:5). Joseph was already there.
- Exodus covers the period from the arrival of Jacob in Egypt (1875 B.C.) to the erecting of the Tabernacle in the wilderness some 431 years later. (1445 B.C.)
- After the death of Joseph, a change of dynasty made Israel a nation of slaves.
- Israel's sojourn in Egypt took place from about 1900-1400 B.C.
- During the time Israel was in Egypt, Egypt became a world empire.
- God raised up Moses to be the deliverer of Israel.
- Moses was a Levite.
- At the time of the Exodus there were 600,000 men above the age of 20 besides the women and children.

## EXODUS

- Probably 3 to 4 million people left Egypt in the Exodus.
- While it took God one night to get Israel out of Egypt, it took 40 years to get Egypt out of Israel.
- With Exodus begins the story of Moses himself.
  - The story of Moses constitutes about one-seventh of the whole Bible.
  - The story of Moses is about two-thirds as large as the New Testament.
- Egyptians were the descendants of Ham.

  - God's Commission of Moses - 3:1 - 4:17
  - The ten plagues - 7:14 - 11:10
  - The beginning of the Passover - 12:1 - 13:14
  - The opening of the Red Sea - 14:13-31
  - The Ten Commandments - 20:1-17
  - Instructions for the Tabernacle - 24:12 - 27:21
  - Offerings for the Tabernacle - 35:1 - 36:7
  - The building of the Tabernacle - 35:1 - 36:7
  - The erecting of the Tabernacle - 40:1-33
  - God filling the Tabernacle - 40:34-38
