- 5. Do you ever find yourself hiding your association with Jesus? Why? What do you think would happen if people knew you were a follower of Jesus?
- 6. How could the good news of Jesus make the world a better place?

Read Colossians 4:2-6. Discuss:

- 7. How can we share the message of Jesus with our actions and the way we live?
- 8. Why is it also important that we share it with our words?
- 9. Do you feel able to clearly proclaim the message of Christ? Why or why not? What do you think you need to be able to?
- 10. What is the relationship between prayer and sharing Jesus?

Application

- 11. Do you have someone in your mind/heart that you sense you need to share Jesus with? Who is it? Let's try to all think of someone.
- 12. What is one way you can engage sharing Jesus in the coming week? (Invite, Alpha, Easter, conversations, kindness, etc.?) Make a plan!
- 13. How can this group support and help you as you seek to share Jesus with that person?

Prayer

- 14. Each person shared a name of someone that they want to share Jesus with. Pray for each of those names and that God would open opportunities in the coming weeks.
- 15. Pray for each other, for boldness, clarity, and confidence in the good news of Jesus.
