Main Point: We are God's plan for sharing the good news of Jesus.

Getting Started

2. Who first told you about Jesus? Tell the story,

Read Luke 19:10 and Matthew 5:13-16. Discuss:

3. Do you feel like you've joined Jesus ("Son of Man") in his purpose? Why or why not?
4. What does salt and light do? Why does Jesus compare his followers to those things?
5. Do you ever find yourself hiding your association with Jesus? Why? What do you think would happen if people knew you were a follower of Jesus?
6. How could the good news of Jesus make the world a better place?

Read Colossians 4:2-6. Discuss:

7. How can we share the message of Jesus with our actions and the way we live?
8. Why is it also important that we share it with our words?
9. Do you feel able to clearly proclaim the message of Christ? Why or why not? What do you think you need to be able to?
10. What is the relationship between prayer and sharing Jesus?

Application

11. Do you have someone in your mind/heart that you sense you need to share Jesus with? Who is it? Let's try to all think of someone.
12. What is one way you can engage sharing Jesus in the coming week? (Invite, Alpha, Easter, conversations, kindness, etc.?) Make a plan!
13. How can this group support and help you as you seek to share Jesus with that person?

14. Each person shared a name of someone that they want to share Jesus with. Pray for each of those names and that God would open opportunities in the coming weeks.
15. Pray for each other, for boldness, clarity, and confidence in the good news of Jesus.
