Part 3 – Equipped to be the Light

Ezekiel 36:26-27, John 15:9-17,

1 Corinthians 13:1-7

God has equipped the church of believers to be the light in a dark world. These are dark times indeed. From the impact of social separation to societal unrest and violence, the very fabric of our country and communities are under attack. How are we as Christians to respond? We are free to surrender our will to our fathers. In this surrendering He will use us to his great work of healing and redemption.

READ: Ezekiel 36:26-27, John 15:9-17, 1 Corinthians 13:1-7

DISCUSS:

- How does fear, anger, and worry impact our response to current events in our country? What does freedom mean to you?
- The “in-dwelling” of the Holy Spirit. What does it mean to live a life of Spirit and Truth vs one of Flesh?
- How Jesus’s temperament as he dealt with the sinfulness and deceit of the Pharisees. What does it mean to you to be “Unoffendable”? Contrast that with “Righteous Indignation”

PRAY & RESPOND:

Pray for God to help you grow in Spirit and Truth and reject your “Fleshy” nature.

Pray for those you fear, distrust, consider lost and those in opposition to your values and beliefs

Engage in difficult conversations (Where you are mostly listening vs talking)

Enter into a deeper walk through an accountability relationship(s)
