- What things are you most tempted to worry about? How does it help or hurt?
- Where do you experience a tension between fear and faith?
- What might it mean for you to seek first the kingdom of God?
 What might it mean for our church?

PRAY:

List the things that cause you worry and anxiety. Choose one item on your list to pray over this week so that your faith may replace your fear.
