Part 3 – Don't Forget to Remember
Psalm 78:1-5, 57

The history of Israel in the Old Testament is a very rhythmic history - rebellion and then redemption. Sin and then forgiveness. Wrath and then mercy. The account of Israel's history was often told and retold so that future generations would always remember God's faithfulness. We all have the responsibility to pass down God's truth to the next generation of Christ followers. We must never forget to remember to tell the story of God's redemption.

READ: Psalm 78:1-5, 57; I Corinthians 10:6

DISCUSS:

- Why is it important for each generation of Christians to make disciples of the next generation? What happens overtime if we stop disciplining our children?
