Message Series Guide Summer on the Mount Part 2 – Salt/Light + Fulfillment of the Law Matthew 5:13-20



To live the Kingdom Life means to live differently. Jesus described it as being salt and light. We can only live this kind of life when we live out the truth of His Word and teach others to do the same.

DISCUSS:

- Describe three ways a believer is to be the salt of the earth.
- Describe how believers are to be the light of the world.
- What was Christ's view of the Old Testament Scripture? How should this affect our view of Scripture in general?
- If believers are not under the law anymore, in what way do we fulfill the righteous requirement of the law through the Spirit?
- Why is it important to have a Christocentric view in studying and teaching Scripture—especially the OT?
- What does the smallest letter or stroke of a letter refer to?
 Why is the endurance and authority of Scripture so important to the Christian faith?
- What is the basis for reward or greatness in the Kingdom of Heaven? How can a believer's righteousness surpass that of the Pharisees to get into Heaven?
- What is the difference between good works being the root of salvation verse the fruit of salvation?
