READ: Luke 10:25-37, Colossian 3:17, Matthew 15:8, Proverbs 3:5-6

DISCUSS:

- Should our faith in Christ define every aspect of our life? Why or why not? How does the Parable of the Good Samaritan illustration faith in all circumstances?
- Why do you think some people compartmentalize their faith? What is the evidence of a compartmentalized faith?
- Which area of your life (relationships, finances, work, family, etc.) is hardest to submit to God's will and guidance?
- How does "seeking first the kingdom of God" bring God's blessing upon our work, family, finances, etc.?

PRAY & RESPOND:

Pray and ask God that your faith will define all the compartments in your life.
