Part 5 – Unknown Self (Workshop)
I Samuel 16:1-13, I Corinthians 12:7-11

Each of us possess certain skills, abilities and passions that were once unknown to us before we discovered them. Likewise, there are unidentified gifts, undiscovered talents, and future callings that are unknown to us and others. But guess what? They are <u>not</u> unknown to God. And He has a desire to develop the unknown areas of our life.

READ: I Samuel 16:1-13, Jeremiah 29:11, Proverbs 19:21, I Corinthians 12:7-11, Acts 13:22, Ephesians 3:20

DISCUSS:

- Why did God reject Saul? Why did Samuel initially think Eliab was the Lord's anointed? What qualities do the world count as most important? What does it mean that God "looks at the heart"?
- What are spiritual gifts? Where do they come from? Who receives them? What are we to use our spiritual gifts to accomplish?
- How does it make you feel that God's has a role for you to play in His grand narrative? How are you going to identify and grow in your gifts?
