As Judah weakens, the Edomite kingdom takes advantage of the situation and sends troops.

After Jerusalem fell, the Babylonians destroyed its fortifications and burnt down the Temple.

Zedekiah tries to escape, but is caught in the plains of Jericho. He is then taken to the king of Babylon at Riblah where he receives his sentence.

Zedekiah is taken prisoner before Nebuchadnezzar, encamped at Riblah.
