Discussion and Questions:

Read the account of the stalker and the herd of pigs in Luke 8:26-39 (or Mark 5:1-20)

1. In what ways can you relate to the “stalker”? How does being someone in a heap of misery and torment remind you of yourself?
2. Ethan said Christianity is a response to God. Look at the ways the people responded in this story. Why do you think Jesus let some of them go and not pursue them?
3. One reason the people wanted Jesus to leave (vs 37) was because what He had done with the pigs cost them a lot. Can you think of something in your Christian life that has cost you something? How did it make you feel?
4. Look at verse 39. What was the man told to do? Who told you how much Jesus has done for you? Who have you told?
5. Pigs represent distractions to our real priorities, we heard. The most effective thing God has given us to reset our priorities is communion. What does communion mean to you?
6. Look up Romans 9:1-3. What would you be prepared to forfeit in order that another may come to the feet of Jesus? What can you collectively do as a group to help someone else?
