Discussion and Questions:

3. Look up Micah 6:8, Jeremiah 22:16 and James 1:27. When read as a group, one can easily get the impression that a life of good deeds is what God requires in order for us to be considered a Christian. Now look up John 3:3 and 16, Hebrews 11:6 and Ephesians 2:8-9. What light do they shed on what must happen for us to be called a Christian?
4. How important is motive when it comes to doing little things for people in secret and why?
5. Darryl said "I am saved because God is good, not because I am good". What did he mean by that?
6. Discuss opportunities you may have as a group to do some little things for someone in need and make a plan now.
