## Discussion and Questions:

Acts 15:1-21.

1. Verse 5 is a classic example of legalism; making man-made rules the priority formula as the way to demonstrate spirituality. Has anyone here ever fallen prey to a legalistic faith? How did you move out of it?
2. The people who brought this rule were described as "...believers who belonged to the party of the Pharisees..." What does this tell us about the power of the gospel and who God is willing to accept? How should we accept those whose faith comes from an intellectual starting point?
3. Peter makes the statement in verse 8 that God knows the heart. His own heart took a while to calm down and feel fully loved by God, didn't it. Look how far Peter has come! What does the truth that God knows your heart fill you with and why?
4. Read verse 11 and Ephesians 2:8-9. What does the phrase 'saved by grace' mean to you and how does it show in your life?
5. Clint said Christianity is often made complicated when really it is not. We need to keep it simple. Paul understood this. Look up 1 Corinthians 1:18, 22-23 and 2:1-2. What is our responsibility to be when preaching the good news?
6. Discuss what not making it difficult (Verse 19) needs to look like. How well do you think LifeSwitch does this?
