Discussion and Questions:

1. Mat started out by sharing a quote from Nelson Mandela. Do you have a favourite quote?
2. In Gal 5:1 Paul says "It is for freedom that Christ has set us free." What do you think this means?
3. The parable of the good Samaritan was told in response to the question "who is my neighbour?" Why do you think we want to limit the definition of neighbour?
4. Mat highlighted four things that prevent us from loving without filters:
 - Race
 - Social Status
 - Reputation
 - CostWhich of these four do you find stops you from loving without filters?
5. Mat said that the question was put to Jesus "who is the neighbour?". Yet Jesus turns this around and finishes the parable asking "who was the neighbour?" Why is this adjustment so powerful?
6. Re-read the parable of the good Samaritan (Luke 10:25-37) and identify the similarities between Jesus and the good Samaritan. (I.e. he paid the price and made a promise to return).
