Find two simple items to represent the broken body and shed blood of our Saviour and partake together, as the Lord has asked us to do (1 Corinthians 11:23-26 and Luke 22:19-20). Perhaps listen to a favourite song or share some verses too. Praise and thank God for His great gift of love, because He is worthy.
