Discussion and Questions:

The account of how David was removed from his paddock to be set on a course for the palace is found in 1 Samuel 16. Skim the first 16 verses to be more familiar with it. It is a great encounter with God.

1. Who would like to tell the group of the day you had a saving encounter with God and He changed the direction of your life forever i.e. when you became a Christian?
2. Look more closely at the last part of verse 7. Why do people think they can hide their hearts from God? Does it work?
3. Logan said “on the other side of obedience is God’s faithfulness”. What did he mean by that?
4. Describe Gods faithfulness. Where would we be without it? (Try Lamentations 3:22-23, Psalm 23:1-4 and Hebrews 13:5-6 to help with your answer. Do you have other verses?)
5. Matt 6:33 was suggested as a place to start with our obedience. If we were to apply this verse, what would our seeking look like? Make a list together of the sorts of things we could do or stop doing.
6. One of the goals of seeking after God’s kingdom and righteousness is for a heart that isn’t afraid to be seen by Him. How can we help each other be more obedient and make changes in our lives that we may achieve that goal? Pray for the person on your left as a sign of encouragement.
