Discussion and Questions:

1. After the music finished, Clint related a story about going to the supermarket and realising, when you get to the checkout, that you've forgotten your wallet. In this scenario, the person behind said "I've got this." Do you think that often we can be the answer to people's prayer needs, if we're tuned in to God?
2. Jono talked on this too, about how we often come across opportunities to help others, but instead we can be too quick to judge. How can we work to improve in this area?
3. Jono also reminded us that healthy people don't need a doctor - sick people do. And Jesus came to heal the sick. What struggles can prevent us from getting alongside the sick, and can we get past these?
4. Instead of saying "I think you should.....", we should be genuinely, continually praying for people. This will help us to become loving helpers. Is there something we can do to better represent Christ in our day-to-day, without coming across as being judgemental?
5. Ann gave us a timely reminder that God REALLY, GENUINELY LOVES US!!! Yet sometimes we let sin get between us and God, and that message becomes diluted. Are there things that you know you should be dealing with today? Is there anything that you could share with the group, and that people could pray with you for?
6. God's offer of freedom from sin is still valid today. Do you have anyone on your heart that you should be praying for, who hasn't made that choice in their lives yet?

Finally, remember that CHRIST IS COMING BACK. We have limited time here on earth, so don't pass up any opportunity to do God's will.
